

# SEPTEMBER UPDATE

The Lunchbowl Network is deeply grateful for the Grants given by The Brothers Trust in support of the wellbeing for children and families from Kibera.

This support has enabled a profound effect on the quality of provision.



GRANT: £4,000  
REMAINING: £1,815

£2,185 was used to renovate the Saturday feeding programme kitchen, allowing our team to work in a smoke free environment when preparing the food

£143 paid for new seatbelts and £1,399 was used to buy new seat covers for the school buses. Costing a total of £1,542



GRANT: £4,000  
REMAINING: £2,550

GRANT: £1,800  
REMAINING: £0



£1,800 bought new blankets and paid for the running of an emergency night kitchen for families that lost their homes in a fire in Kibera in February.



£709 allowed us to upgrade the DT room at The Good Samaritan School.

GRANT: £1,700  
REMAINING: £991



£2,500 paid for new equipment for the science laboratory

GRANT: £2,500  
REMAINING: £0

The remaining £5,356 will fund the building of a new science laboratory and a Grade 9 classroom on site. With these additions we will be able to register with the Ministry of Education as a Junior Secondary School, thereby taking children up to the age of 15 years instead of 14 years.
